

Will Augwind's 'airbattery' energy storage system work in Germany?

The facility will be the first operational installation at scale of Augwind's 'AirBattery' hydraulic compressed air energy storage (CAES) system designed specifically for grid-scale energy storage for up to months at a time. Germany has over 400 caverns suitable for AirBattery, and geological potential for storing 330 TWh in total.

Can compressed air energy storage be used in flat areas?

Compressed air energy storage systems, on the other hand, can also be used in flat areas. In windy northern Germany, for example, compressed air energy storage facilities using underground storage volumes - so-called salt caverns - with low land consumption and marginal environmental impact can be used to shift large amounts of energy.

What is compressed air energy storage?

Compressed air energy storage (CAES) is a form of long-duration energy storage. When there is a surplus of sustainable electricity, this energy can be used to compress air with a capacity of 220 MW. This air will then be stored in salt caverns, cavities in the ground at a depth of around a kilometre under the surface.
