In most cases, yes, you can install solar panels on your home if it is governed by an HOA, though you will likely have to submit a request. Many states and territories have enacted solar access laws, which prevent HOAs ...

The average residential solar system, including installation, costs \$20,650, says EnergySage, an online alternative energy marketplace.

Currently, residential solar installations typically range from \$2.50 to \$3.50 per watt before incentives. This means a 6-kilowatt system (6,000 watts) would cost between \$15,000 and \$21,000 before ...
