The dimensions of 72-cell solar panels are as follows: 77 inches long, and 39 inches wide. That's a 77" x 39 solar panel; basically, a longer panel, mostly used for commercial solar systems.

For example, a 300W solar panel typically measures about 1.6m x 1m, a 400W solar panel typically measures about 1.7m x 1.2m, and a 1 kW solar panel typically measures about 1.9m x 1.5m.
