How is energy efficiency regulated in Morocco?

However, energy efficiency is specifically regulated by Law 47-09 on energy efficiency. Devices and equipment commercialised in Morocco using electricity, natural gas, gaseous or liquid oil products, coal and renewable energies must comply with minimum energy performance requirements.

What does Morocco's law 16-09 mean for rural electrification?

Law No. 16-09 supports stand-alone renewable systems for rural electrification while extending its scope to medium-voltage grid-connected solutions in rural areas, bridging gaps in energy access for remote regions.
