George Cove was born in Amherst, Nova Scotia, in 1863 or 1864. His father Joseph Cove patented many mechanical devices. His mother, Ann, was also born in Nova Scotia, and her parents were from Ireland. In 1904-05, Cove developed his "solar electric generator" which he displayed at the Metropole Building in Halifax, Nova Scotia. Word of this device reached American investors, and a plant to develop more devices was planned in Somerville, Massachusetts. In 1906, Cove patented a device for capturing tida...

While researching the economics of clean energy innovation, I came across a little-known story: that of Canadian inventor George Cove, one of the world's first renewable energy entrepreneurs.

But who invented solar generators depends very much on how you look at it. The first scientist to discover that two metal electrodes placed in an electrolyte solution produced more energy ...

In 1953, Telkes helped invent a solar-powered oven and in the 1960s carried out research on photovoltaic cells - now the bedrock of the solar energy industry.

In the 1860s, August Mouchet came up with solar-powered steam engines.

George Cove had a patent for his solar energy device and a registered company called "Sun Electric Generator Corporation". Cove's invention could produce electricity by harnessing the photovoltaic ...
